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Swinto is “Crow” in the language of the Huarpe Indians, the first inhabitants of the Mendoza river valley. A brilliant deep garnet color. Complex, darkly fruity and earthy on the nose, with a luscious palate of ripe red stone fruits and jams accented with spicy, toasty notes. Generously flavorful, dense and unfiltered, Swinto achieves an outstanding balance of Malbec’s signature robust character and silky elegance.
