Swinto means "crow" in the language of the Huarpe Indians, the first inhabitants of the Mendoza river valley. For more than 100 years, our vineyards have thrived in this extraordinary area, within the region of Agrelo, Luján de Cuyo that soars to 3,346 feet above sea level. Yields of barely 1.5 tons per acre and meticulous selection of the best clusters capture the greatest expression of the Malbec grape, enhanced by malolactic fermentation in new French oak barrels and aging in the same barrels for 15 months.

A brilliant deep garnet color, Swinto is complex, darkly fruity and mineral on the nose, with a luscious palate of ripe red stone fruits and jams accented with spicy, toasty notes. Generously flavorful, dense and unfiltered, Swinto achieves an outstanding balance of Malbec's signature robust character and silky elegance.
